COVID-19 POLICY 2

RESPONSIBILITIES: All members are required to adhere with policy guidance fully and all supervisors are required to enforce this policy. Failure to adhere with policy will result in disciplinary action up to and including dismissal, IAW Law, Rule and Regulations.

NOTE: This is dramatic changes to our operations but I believe they are imperative to maintain the health and safety of our personnel. It is noted, that increased hygiene is required and handwashing or use alcohol based cleaners after use of all PPE.

UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS:

It will be **MANDATORY** that all **PERSONNEL** have two uniforms on hand for each duty day.

Operations:

1. The second uniform will be used after decon/showering while your uniform is being washed at the station on **SANITIZE** settings.
2. This will be done with PPE- Eye Protection, N-95 and Gloves
3. This can be maintained in your locker and be readily accessible for use.

Dispatch:

1. The second uniform will be used, if you have contact with a person suspected of COVID-19 after decon/showering while your uniform is being washed at the station on **SANITIZE** setting.
2. This will be done with PPE- Eye Protection, N-95 and Gloves
3. This can be maintained in your locker/gym bag/vehicle and be readily accessible for use.

Administration, Prevention, Logistics:

1. The second uniform will be used, if you have contact with a person suspected of COVID-19 after decon/showering while your uniform is being washed at the station on **SANITIZE** setting.
2. This will be done with PPE- Eye Protection, N-95 and Gloves
3. This can be maintained in your locker/gym bag/vehicle and be readily accessible for use.
