
Executive Summary

Over the past 24 hours, ODH reported 365 (38,476) total new cases, 37 (6,497) hospitalizations, 7 (1,657) ICU Admissions, and 7 (2,377) deaths. Each metric was below the respective 21-day averages.

No new hot spots were identified over the past 48 hours. The State EOC continues to support local hot spot identifiecation, prevention, and mitigation efforts through planning and mission support.

The State EOC is preparing for this week's statewide PPE pushes, scheduled for June 8 and June 10.




