Current Situation:

Public Health – Dayton & Montgomery County, the Ohio Department of Health (ODH) Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and World Health Organization (WHO) continued to respond to the COVID-19 Pandemic.

Current Updates:

- It needs to be continually enforced that we are still in the middle of a pandemic. Enforce social distancing, hand-washing and the wear of masks.
- Globally the World now has 48,171,563 cases and 1,226,241 deaths from COVID-19.
- The Ohio Department of health COVID-19 vaccination plan was released
- Public Health will hold pop-up testing on November 10, 2020 from 12 PM to 5 PM. It will be held at the Montgomery County Fairgrounds.
- Cases continue to increase a t a very high rate.
- Ohio set its largest one-day total of 4,961 cases today, November 5, 2020.
- 56` counties as of today fall under a level 3 (red) category. •
- Montgomery County remains at a level 3 (red) category.
- The positivity rate within Montgomery County is currently at 8.8%.
- Montgomery County currently has 366.4 cases per 100,000 population, placing us at 21st in the state.
- 6 of the 8 counties within West Central Ohio fall within the top 20 of cases per 100,000 population.
- All 88 counties within Ohio now fall under a high incidence county based on having more than 100 cases per 100,000 population.
- Stephanie McCloud named as new Health Director for ODH.



- Travel advisory issued: Individuals traveling to Ohio from 7 states urged to selfquarantine for 14 days.
 - These include Montana, Idaho, South Dakota, Wyoming, Iowa, Kansas, and Alabama

- Governor DeWine is conducting calls with key partners in each county on ways to improve the response. He is currently working his way down the case rates by county.
- The Public Health COVID-19 informational phone line remains open Monday through Friday to answer general questions. The info line is 937-225-6217.
- ODH information line remains open, the number is 1-833-4-ASK-ODH and is open seven days a week.
- Public Health continues to monitor all sources (ODH, CDC, WHO, European Center for Disease and Prevention and Control (ECOC) for the latest information.
- Public Health maintains its one-week operational period for this response.
- Public Health will continue to share the situational report with other local health departments, Montgomery County Emergency Management, Greater Dayton Area Hospital Association and Dayton Metropolitan Medical Response System partners.


