



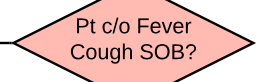
Cincinnati Fire Department COVID-19 Response



ALL 911 calls for Fever, Cough, SOB screened at dispatch



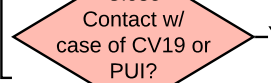
Normal Dispatch w/ info in Run



Co. Level Screening (at >6' if possible)



w/ in 14 days




Proceed to evaluate & treat for other causes as indicated (*Resp/Full PPE only if needed)

Standard Operating Procedures for PPE and DECON




CFD Personnel

- DON PPE
- Tyvek Suit or Barrier w/ Sleeves
- Overhaul Mask
- Gloves



Patient and Treatment

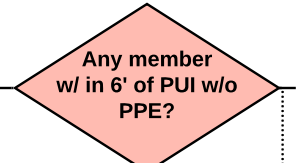
- Place Surgical Mask on Pt. Before and During Transport
- If oxygen is needed COVER NRM or Cannula with Mask
- Exercise caution if an aerosol-generating procedure (e.g. BVM, CPAP)



Transport

- Attendant to wear proper level of PPE
- Driver to CLOSE door to Pt. Compartment
- CHECK ventilation Systems

DECON

Personnel

1. Remove Suit and Gloves
2. Wash/Hand Sanitizer
3. Remove Mask/Eye Protection
4. Bag and discard
5. Wash/Hands Sanitizer

remove & bag uniform to be cleaned in regular laundry

Equipment & Apparatus

1. Wear Gloves and Eye protection
2. Wipe all surfaces and equipment with approved cleaner
3. Utilize UV system if available
4. Wipe down Overhaul Mask for reuse
5. Wash/Hands Sanitizer

Hospital Notification

- DO NOT use RADIO
- ALERT receiving hospital over the phone
