EXPOSURE INCIDENT

On Scene Wound Care

Notify the Receiving Hospital

Notify Fire/EMS Supervisor

Check-in as a Patient at ED

Complete RIECW Form & Provide to Nurse

Supervisor Contacts Department's Infection Control Officer

Infection Control Officer Consults with Departments Medical Director

Hospital Initiate Source Testing Procedures

Medical Evaluation

Draw Specified Labs

RX Prophylaxis as Prescribed

Counseling

Discharge

Infection Control Officer Notifies Receiving Hospital's EMS Coordinator

Prescribed Labs:
HIV antibody
Hepatitis B surface antibody
Hepatitis C virus antibody

Positive Source Patient
Hepatitis C or HIV = Viral Load

Complete Departmental Injury/Exposure Paperwork

Hospital Designated Infection Control POC Notifies Exposed Employee of ANY Outstanding Lab Results or Required Follow-up

Exposed Employee Notifies Department Infection Control Officer of Results & Need for Additional Follow-up

Infection Control Officer Coordinates Follow-up As Needed with Department's Work Place Health Provider
